**\*Poster Update**

**\*Curriculum**

Pam brought a copy of the lesson plans developed by Clayton Russell's class at Northland College. The plans are for pre-kindergarten to 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> grade, and two for middle school.

- Steven wrote an article on NWI and submitted it to the Forest Service Regional Office in Milwaukee. The Regional Office was looking for information on projects with diverse partners. The article could result in a visit from the Chief of the Forest Service and/or the Secretary of Agriculture.
- Welcome to Ben Dufford—Wetlands Project Coordinator for ABDI Land Conservation Department.
- No word yet on the Great Lakes Coastal Program grant application (submitted late December). Quita Sheehan has taken a job with the DNR so will be unable to fill the Coordinator position if we do get funding. Ben offered to check on additional funding sources.
